- Develop tools and methods to be used by Entergy's domestic utility for generation supply planning including valuation of resources
- Providing analytical support for selecting and managing Entergy's portfolio of supply-side resources
- Forecasting commodity and electric power prices

- Assessing the financial implications of supply decisions
- Identifying and assessing market threats and opportunities
