

What Requires A Permit?

All shoreline facilities, structures and activities on Entergy's Project 271 lands or water require a permit from Entergy prior to installation or placement. Some of the most common types of facilities, structures and activities that require a permit include, but are not limited to:

Piers	Landings
Boat Docks	Bulkheads
PWC Ramps/Docks	Seawalls
Boardwalks	Fill
Decks	Dredge
Inflatable Platforms (e.g. trampoline)	Riprap
Walkways	Excavation
Boat Lifts (when outside the facility's slip)	Water Withdrawal
Steps	Roads
Heat/Air Exchange Piping	Vegetation Removal
Waterlines	Bridges
Utility Facilities	Regulatory Buoys
Landscape Plantings	Mooring Buoys

NOTE:

In addition, permits are required for the modifications, replacement and additions to existing facilities, structures or activities.
