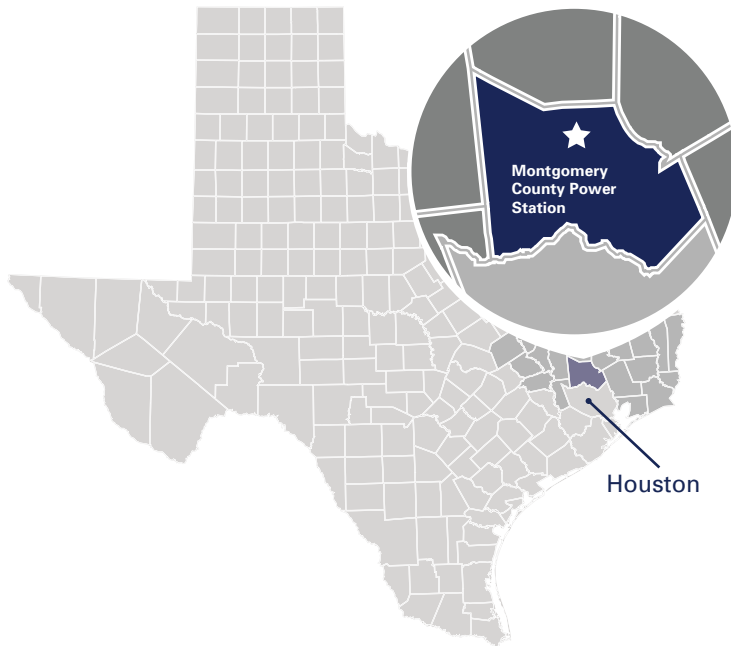


# Powering tomorrow with the Montgomery County Power Station.
