What is The Power to Care?

At Entergy, we believe that no one should have to choose between essential needs like food, medicine and electricity. Through The Power to Care program, we provide emergency utility bill payment assistance to older adults and individuals with disabilities facing financial hardships.

Empowering our community

The Power to Care offers vital support to our most vulnerable neighbors, helping them maintain their electricity during challenging times. By gathering generous donations from shareholders, customers, and employees, we partner with local nonprofit agencies to ensure that these funds directly assist our qualifying customers with their electric and gas bills.

Are you eligible?

The Power to Care program assists our customers in need, including households with adults aged 60 years and older/individuals with disabilities are eligible who meet 150% to 200% of the federal poverty level.

The applicants need to provide:

- Disconnection or pending disconnection notice if applicable (available in the FINA portal).
- Government-issued photo ID.
- Entergy bill no older than 30 days (available in the FINA portal).
- Check stubs from the previous 30 days for all employed household members.
- Proof of unearned income (Social Security, unemployment insurance, Veterans Affairs retirement, disability, etc.) is required.
- Additional information may be required.

Clients aged 55 or older may qualify if they are mentally or physically disabled, or if they have a disabled spouse or dependent who is receiving Social Security Disability. Eligibility also requires meeting either 150% to 200% of the federal poverty level.

- SSA (Survivor's Benefits do not qualify as disability).
- Short-term/long term disability does not qualify unless they are over 60.
- Workman's compensation does not qualify unless they are over 60.
