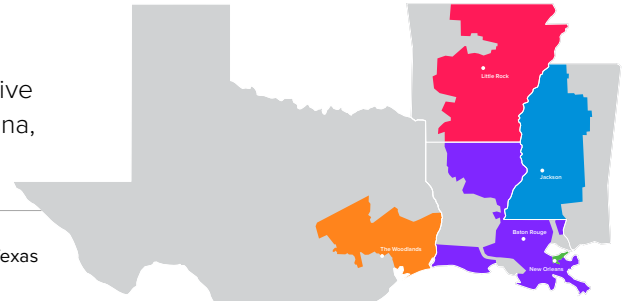

## Electric utilities and infrastructure

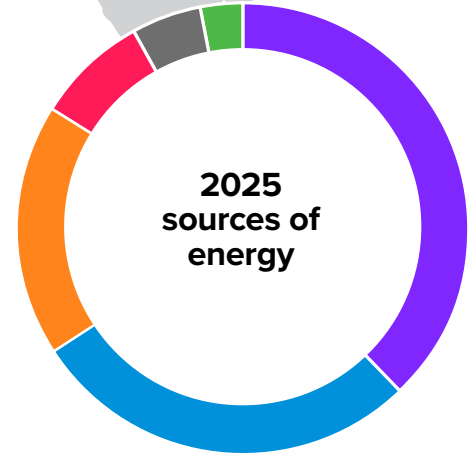
