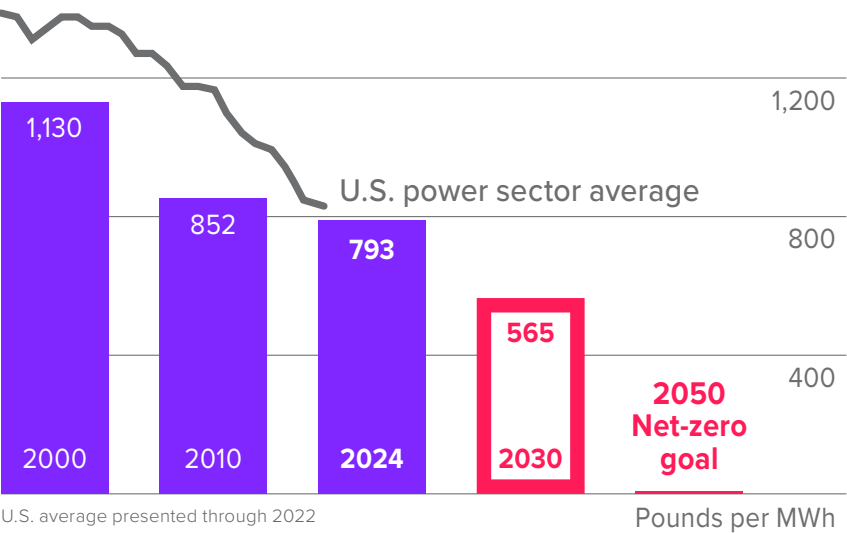

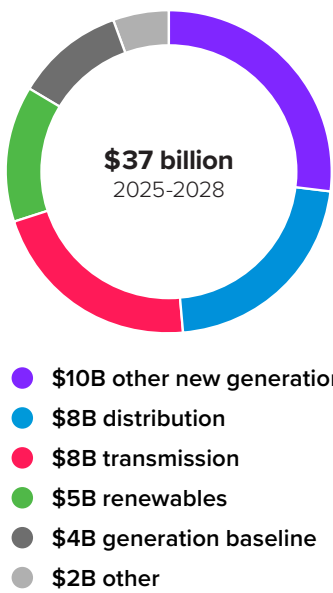
Progress toward our 2050 net-zero commitment
